It is noted for the record that the Accrediting Commission originally considered the institution's application for initial accreditation at its December 2024 meeting. After reviewing the team report (visit conducted October 22-23, 2024), and the institution's response to that report (received December 2, 2024), the Commission voted to defer final action and directed the institution to submit an interim report to address its outstanding concerns regarding Standards II.C. Human Resource Management, VI.B. Supervision of Instruction, and IX.D. Completion and Job Placement.

At the April 2025 meeting, upon review of the institution's substantive interim report, dated February 28, 2025, the Commission voted to grant reaccreditation.

The Commission commends the institution on its efforts toward meeting the Standards for Accreditation and is confident that the institution will continue to review, monitor, and enhance its operations to ensure the high quality of education and training toward which we all strive.

ACCET reminds the institution to update its website to accurately reflect its new accredited status. ACCET accreditation status involves several operational review and approval processes prior to implementation and, similarly, reporting requirements pertinent to specific triggering events. These are outlined in ACCET Document 14 – ACCET Reporting Requirements, which can be found on the ACCET website (www.accet.org) under Documents and Forms, and copies of which should be shared with all affected staff at the institution to ensure compliance with these essential requirements.

Please be reminded that per ACCET Document 11, a one-day Quality Assurance Visit will be conducted during the institution's current grant of accreditation. The team's review will include an assessment of any areas cited as weaknesses during the last reaccreditation visit in order to validate that corrective actions have been systematically and effectively implemented to ensure a positive impact on the institution's operations.

The appropriate state and federal education officials will be notified of this action by copy of this letter. The institution is advised to visit the ACCET website at www.accet.org for timely updates and to download the most current information, policy documents, and forms.

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ACCET's mission is to inspire and promote quality-oriented continuing education and training. As *A Partnership for Quality®*, the ACCET accreditation process represents both an organizational commitment to and a strategic plan for quality training.
